Let's learn French in France at the museum!

1. Dictionary

Illustrated, and with all the useful vocabulary for this module.

2. Artists game

Easy mode: All the blue artwork title cards are face up on the table, and the 6 artworks cards face down. One artwork card is revealed, and the first person to place their finger on the correct title card wins the pair. The player with the most pairs at the end of the game wins!

- This game works best with a gamemaster who can check responses.



Memory mode: Mix 6 cards with the artworks with the 6 cards with the names of the paintings and put them face down on the table. Each player turns over two cards to try to find a pair. The player with the most pairs at the end of the game wins!

3. Pictionary


Material: The set of square purple cards, crayons in black, red and grey, and paper.

One player (the artist) picks a purple card and draws the concept that is written on it. He cannot write letters or numbers. The other players try to guess what he is drawing.

The first player to find the noun and the adjective in French wins a point, as well as the artist.

All pupils play the artist at some point in the game.

At the end, the player with the most points wins.



4. Timeline

This game needs a gamemaster who will check each answer with the timeline below and two players.

Mix the 6 blue cards with the artworks and put them face down on the table.

A first card is put face up on the table by the gamemaster.

The first player picks a card and places it before or after the card on the table, depending on its age. The gamemaster checks the answer. If the card was in its right place, the player wins a point. If not, the card is put at the right place, and he does not win a point.

Each player turns one card over and places it in the right place. The player with the most points at the end of the game wins.





5. Je vois... (I see...)

Mix the 12 square purple cards with the word combinations and put them in a pile. Reveal the “Je vois” board. Turn over one card (for instance, “un chat blanc” (a white cat)) The first player to find a white cat on the board and to say “Je vois un chat blanc” (I see a white cat) wins the card. The dictionary can be used in case it is too difficult. Then, the next card is revealed. The player with the most cards at the end of the game wins!



6. “Au musée” drawing

This drawing combines all the artworks of the cards. Can you find them all and use them as inspiration to colour it in?

7. Comics reading comprehension

Use it to practice reading comprehension, to read aloud to practice pronunciation and interactions, or as a base for a short role play!

8. Museum die

Build the die, then throw it. The first to be able to give a French word that can be used to describe the image wins a point! (Check with the dictionary)

- This game can be played with a gamemaster who checks answers. Throw ten times, the winner is the one with the most points!
- Alternative: Give the title of the artwork and its artist (1 point per element)


