## Guidance Note – How to Use the “physical content” as pedagogical materials

 The content includes:

- dictionary
- dictionary cards
- number cards

 These cards can be used:

- by theme, or by mixing themes
- as simple flashcards
- for pair or group games, such as:
  - a. a memory game (goal: find matching pairs)
  - b. a battle game (goal: players flip cards and look for matches)
  - c. a word association game

 The cards offer multiple playful uses that support learning through fun and interaction.

 You will also find blank cards, allowing you to create your own content based on your learners' needs and ideas.

# INSTRUCTIONS TO PLAY

The game can be played by 2 to 4 players.

Each player must choose a chip (Purple, blue, red, or yellow) or the badge of their favourite German football club and roll the dice.

The player with the highest number will start the game.

To play, each participant must roll the dice and move his/her piece to the corresponding square.


In each grey square, there must be a picture.

If he/she names correctly, he/she can move forward; if not, it is the next player's turn.

On the board, there are also 6 special squares (in red with an angry emoticon) in which the player loses a turn without playing.

The player who reaches the finish line first wins.











