

# Physical Content - AT THE SHOP - let's discover GERMAN

🌱 Guidance Note – How to Use the “physical content” as pedagogical materials

In this folder, you will find downloadable and printable teaching materials to help you build your own language awareness activities.

🧑🏫📄 The content includes:

- colour cards
- number cards
- fruit cards
- a family card game
- a fortune teller (also known as a paper "cootie catcher")
- fake euro coins for shopping role-play
- two comics featuring the discovered words

📄 These cards can be used:

- by theme, or by mixing themes
- as simple flashcards
- for pair or group games, such as:
  - a memory game (goal: find matching pairs by turning cards face down)
  - a battle game (goal: players each flip a card from their own pile at the same time - the fastest to spot a match wins the round)
  - a family game (goal : find the 4 cards of the same family)

💡 The cards offer multiple playful uses that support learning through fun and interaction.

✍️ You will also find blank cards, allowing you to create your own content based on your learners' needs and ideas.


🎯 The fortune teller combines different themes in a dynamic and engaging way. Children can also customise their fortune teller by hiding “surprises” under the flaps for the other players.

📖 The comics can be used as a model to invent a dialogue, a roleplay or a short theatre scene using the key phrases from the activity.


🗣️ Whatever game you choose, always encourage children to say out loud what they see, point to, or discover. This enhances oral expression and memory.


1 With pictures face down, fold on both diagonal lines. Unfold.




4 Once again, fold all corners to the centre.




2 Fold all four corners to the centre.




5 Fold paper in half and unfold.

7 Slide thumbs and forefingers under the squares and move the fortune teller back and forth to play.


